Join Us at the Annual Meeting for a Presentation by ESS Group on Management of Invasive Aquatic Vegetation

The District engaged the services of the ESS Group of Providence, RI to identify and map the weed population and obtain necessary permits for the management of invasive aquatic vegetation. A visual presentation is planned to show that Fanwort, a prolific and difficult to control invasive weed that has already infested the coves on the northern end of the lake, is spreading throughout the lake. A significant population has taken root along the southwest shoreline near the dam. Summer of 2014 saw an increased issue with Najas weed, causing my proprietors to remove very large clumps from around shorelines and docks.

Lake is Filling

There was no need to keep the water level down this Spring to complete dam repairs. Repairs to the core wall of the dam last fall stopped a known leak east of the spillway. Ice out finally occurred on April 13th and the flash boards were reinstalled in the spillway channel on April 25th. Lake is currently filling to capacity.

Boater and Swimmer Safety Reminder

Boaters, it is illegal to operate a vessel at more than headway speed within 150 feet of shorelines used as swimming areas, rafts, floats and swimmers. Swimmers, please note that Massachusetts law states that no person shall swim or float more than 50 feet from shore unless accompanied by a boat. Massachusetts water craft regulations also state that no craft may operate faster than 10 miles per hour between the hours of sunset and sunrise. Powered craft must display running lights and unpowered craft must carry flashlight or lanterns.
