Minutes of Previous Meetings

The previously distributed minutes of the April 13, 2017 Management Committee Meetings were offered for approval. A motion was made, seconded, and voted unanimously to accept the Minutes.

Clerk's Report

See attached memorandum dated May 11, 2017 for Clerk's report of communications for the period 4/14/17 through 5/11/17. 29 Fairview Drive has been listed for sale. The relator letter was updated and reviewed. A letter will be sent to Mr. Borci and his relator within a week of the May 11, 2017 meeting.

Treasurer's Report

A Treasurer's Report dated 5/11/17 showed that the District had \$457,764.77 on deposit in the Spencer Savings Bank. Of this amount, \$402,936.33 was deposited in the money market account containing betterment payments. The report shows 4 betterment deposits (\$17,279.07 is FY17 betterment collections, \$12,225.29 and \$1331.13 are payoffs of 26 Lake Shore Drive's Betterment, and \$9,811.06 is payoff of 25 Rawson Drive's Betterment) and an interest deposit of \$152.79. Of the remained, \$53,703.02 was in a general funds checking account. The report shows one deposit of \$17,926.29 from FY17 tax payments. The report shows one payments: (1) \$103.69 for Treasurer's expenses. \$1,125.42 was in the stabilization account. Mr. O'Coin requested and was granted approval for Warrant number 204.

FY2016 Tax Payment Update

FY17 tax collections have just begun. 92 proprietors owe tax payments: 6 proprietors have paid in full, 55 proprietors have paid half, and 31 proprietors have paid none. The results in \$12,862.38 (~37%) of the total projected tax payments. This payment profile is in line with the timing of collections.

FY2017 Betterments Update

93 proprietors owed betterment payment (Green Mountain Club is included). 13 proprietors have pre-paid, 7 have been paid off in full. Therefore, 73 proprietors are making betterment payments: 65 proprietors have paid in full, 4 proprietors have paid half, and 4 proprietors have paid none. 95.3% of the projected betterment payments have been collected. This payment profile is in line with the timing of collections and payment profiles of the last years.

Old Business

Lake Level Management Update

The Fall 2016 draw down was completed as directed in the OOC. In the upcoming year, the flash boards should be replaced with new pieces of plywood. The District will plan to work on this replacement. The lake is currently filling. Depending on rain and weather conditions, the flash boards will most likely be installed prior to the April 13 Management Committee Meeting. The flash boards are installed on April 8, 2017 following the District's OOC. As of today, May 11, the water level was exactly level with the spillway.

Conflict of Interest Training

An email was received reminding the District about requiring Conflict of Interest Law training. Each member of the District Management committee was sent the message with a link to the online training program. The District members continue to complete the required training as specified.

Preparation for the Annual Meeting

Mr. Johnston suggested creating a Dam Repair Reserve Account. Although the dam is not in need to immediate repairs, it is a reasonable idea for the District to be saving money for repairs that might be necessary at some future date. Due to the language needed to create this account, this will be need to be a warrant item on the 2018 Annual Meeting Warrant.

New Business

Order of Conditions to Website

Dick Johnston will be contacted to determine if there are an Order of Conditions that applies to the general maintenance of the shore line of Cedar Meadow Pond. if such a document is in existence, the District will post this information to the District website.

Executive Session

The meeting was not recessed to go into Executive Session.
